May 25, 1932 - September 19, 2017

Mr. Glenn Head, age 85 of Rockmart passed away Tuesday morning, September 19, 2017.

Mr. Head was born May 25, 1932 in Rockmart, son of the late Mark Head and the late Lois Dobbs Head. He was a graduate of the Rockmart High School Class of 1951 and attended Coosa Valley Technical College for two years studying to be a tool and die maker. Mr. Head was a veteran of the United States Air Force having served during the Korean Conflict and was a member of the American Legion Brown-Wright Post 12. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Rockmart where he served as a Sunday School Teacher and retired from Georgia Power's Plant Bowen.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by two sisters, Frances Head and Mildred Martin; and a brother, Albert Head.

Survivors include his wife of 57 years, Glenda Morgan Head; daughter and son-in-law, Missy and Sammy Barrett; sister, Clara Scott all of Rockmart; two grandchildren, Cody (Stephanie) Barrett and Victoria Barrett also survive.
